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INTRODUCTION

The cumulative bibliography and indices in this volume cover all entries in the Census-Catalogue, as amended by the additions, deletions, and corrections for Volumes I-III included in the Volume IV Supplement. Because of these emendations, some references found in the bibliographies and indices of Volumes I-III have been deleted here, while other references pertaining to material in those volumes appear here for the first time. The cumulative general index has also been expanded to include citations of Volume I sources under the headings "Antiquarian booksellers, dealers, and auctioneers," "Cathedrals, churches, and chapels," "Courts," and "Monastic institutions" (categories not introduced until Volume II). Thus, although the indices in Volumes I-III remain substantially valid, users of the Catalogue will find it advantageous to consult the present volume in most instances, to assure access to the best current information.

Two sections of this volume present completely new material which will offer additional assistance in surveying and gaining access to the contents of the Census-Catalogue:

1. The section, "Distribution of Manuscripts, by Country, City, and Library," has two purposes. The first is to provide certain information absent from the entries of the Census-Catalogue, by presenting a list of cities and libraries arranged under their respective *countries*, rather than under the single alphabetical series of *city* names used in the Catalogue. In this section, countries are listed in alphabetical order; under each country, its cities and their libraries are listed, also in alphabetical order. Since this listing by countries is analogous to the arrangement used in publications of the *Répertoire International des Sources*
